

Resumen del primer año de la nueva gestion del Ayuntamiento en Orihuela Costa



There is a municipal team dedicated to the Orihuela Costa and headed by Antonio Aniorte at the Ayuntamiento in Playa Flamenca.



Installation of new and improved pumping stations to cope with the rainwater in La Zenia, Campoamor and Los Balcones.

The introduction of new public parks and children's play-areas.



Major investment in public education and related infrastructure. The new high school will receive a total investment of more than 9.500.000 €. The project, in the Villamartin area, is at the tender stage at present with more than 30 companies submitting tenders and construction is expected to start in approximately one month.

Also the new primary school (Nº 18) scheduled for La Florida is already in the planning phase and tenders will be invited in due course.





The construction of 142 social funded apartments in an excellent location of Orihuela Costa build with high quality materials for an affordable price, including a social centre on the ground floor (1.500 m2).



Significant increases in the local police force to ensure citizen security. The number of local police officers already tripled recently and further officers will be added in groups of fifteen each time. By 2010/11 we will have more than 200 local police officers in Orihuela. This is the highest police to citizen ratio in the Comunidad Valenciana.



In mid-October we will present the Local Police Station project to the public. This new facility will have an integrated security centre equipped with the latest technology.



Additional Leisure and Sport facilities are being placed in different areas of the coast such as the new football and basketball grounds in area of La Campana.

The projected scheme for the Orihuela Costa Sport Complex will be presented to the public in October.



Opening of a new Office for International Residents which will have the latest technology to assist residents with information and problem solving.

Two Tourist offices with an integrated reference library and reading room in Playa Flamenca and Campoamor.

Introduction and improvement of the Public Transport systems linking the Urbanisations to the Centro Salud and to the Hospital.





Six beaches and the Cabo Roig marina in Orihuela Costa have received the Blue Flag award this year. The planned installation of an elevator in Punta Prima will greatly assist elderly and handicapped visitors and help this beach acquire the Blue Flag status next year.

Creating of a protected natural area in Aquamarina which includes a paleontologist beach and areas where indigenous species and flora are protected.



The Via Parque Project, which is the dual-carriageway enlargement of the CN-332, has already started and in cooperation with the Valencian government and the Ministry of Public Works, we will have a dual-carriage way, two lanes going to Mil Palmeras and two to Punta Prima, in 2009-2010. This project has a total investment of 20 Millions Euros. New pedestrian bridges and bicycle lanes will be included to facilitate safe and easy access to the beaches, urbanisations and commercial areas.

This year has been a very fruitful and beneficial year for citizens of the Orihuela Costa.
